
Based on our World Championship winning YZ motocross machinery, the DT is a virtual race replica adapted for dual purpose on and off the road. The similarities between the DT125R and our Grand Prix YZ factory bikes are not just cosmetic.

As with our YZ's, the latest DT125R features a 2-stroke crankcase induction motor for instantaneous throttle response. With Yamaha's famous Power Valve System, 28mm flat slide carburettor and Yamaha Energy Induction System, the engine produces a wide spread of power ideal for on and off road situations.

The chassis is closely based on the YZ design. Long travel large diameter front forks combined with Yamaha's world beating Monocross suspension system give one of the best dual purpose set-ups available for precise on road handling and confidence-inspiring off road performance.

And for excellent stopping power we've fitted front and rear disc brakes virtually identical to those used on our factory motocrossers.

## Instrument panel

Rider's eye view of the compact instrument panels shows speedometer, tachometer, water temperature gauge and indicator lights. Protected by the tough polypropylene enduro style front number plate, the instruments supply easy to read information at a glance.

Rear suspension

Developed from Venetor's World Chambianthis exists.

Developed from Yamaha's World Championship racing programme, the Monocross rear suspension features a De Carbon type shock absorber. The extra strong box section swinging arm ensures precise rear wheel tracking even on the harshest terrain.

# Fuel tank and radiator

Large capacity dual radiators keep the DT's motor cool even when ridden to the limit. Ten litre tank features a lockable filler cap for extra security, and like the radiators, is mounted low to reduce the centre of gravity and enhance handling.

Engine
The DT's powerplant reveals the machine's close technological ties with our factory racers. The fuel/air mix is fed directly into the crankcase through a TM28SS flat slide carburettor, a set-up giving instant throttle response. Developed from our motocross and road racing programmes, the Venncha Engraph Industries System (VEIS). programmes, the Yamaha Energy Inductions System (YEIS) improves bottom to mid range torque.
