- The 600cm<sup>3</sup>, 4-cylinder, air-cooled with SACS engine features smooth-revving power and strong mid-range punch.
- Responsive CVR32 carburetors with a throttle position sensor (TPS), and independent ignition mapping, ensure fine control over ignition spark timing for excellent low-end throttle response and low-to-mid range power, plus superb fuel efficiency.
- Full double-cradle frame featuring wide tank rails is highly rigid, and while making a powerful styling statement, provides an unobstructed view of the powerplant. The chassis geometry was carefully chosen to provide a superb combination of straightline stability and responsive steering.
- The 41mm cartridge fork has a dust cover for added durability.
- The link-type rear suspension, with a separator in the shock, delivers consistent response under load. Spring-preload and rebound-damping adjustments provided.
- The GSF600S's comfortable upright riding position and the well-shaped seat with non-slip leather provide hours of fatigue-free riding. Underseat storage space for a U-lock and light rain gear. Convenient grab bar.
- Double front disc brakes with floating disc mounts, sintered-metal pads and large-diameter brake pistons, together with a single rear disc brake, provide superb stopping power and an excellent "feel." The front brake lever is adjustable.

- Wide, low-profile radial tires offer a firm grip on the road.
- The wide, tall windscreen features a turbulence-reducing scoop for increased rider comfort at high speed.
- Purposeful dual projector headlamps, mounted in a chrome extension plate, and sharp-looking rear combination lamp with sparkling-cut back panel, let you see and be seen.
- The cowl-mounted electric step-motor tachometer/speedometer with LCD odometer, twin tripmeter and fuel gauge is responsive and durable.
- Large 20-liter fuel tank extends riding fun between refueling stops.
- User-friendly details include the centerstand's cantilever design that makes it easier to put the Bandit 600S up on its stand.
