If you love high power, breathtaking cornering and precision riding, the CBR600F adds a new dimension to your desires. A desire for the perfect balance between comfort and exhilaration. A desire for the complete motorcycling experience. A desire for a bike that lets you go all out for maximum acceleration. The Honda CBR600F offers you all of this. As a performance bike it is an exception to the rule: simultaneously ultra-sporty, yet forgiving and docile where it counts.

Designed to win

Benefiting from Honda's wealth of experience and technology, the CBR600F has a highly favourable power-to-weight ratio: 100 PS (DIN) for just 185 kg. In competitive motorcycle sport, the CBR600F regularly lives up to this potential wherever it appears. Time and again it has demonstrated its reliability in World Endurance Championship trials such as Le Mans 24 Hours, Spa 24 Hours and Bol d'Or. The CBR600F has also occupied all the podiums of the World Thunderbike Championship - one of the most demanding competitive motorcycling events ever. A winner on the track, it also dominates on the road, demonstrating a better all-round performance than many 750 cc class machines.

Phenomenal power

Especially compact and light, the CBR600F derives its high power from a 599 cm³ 16-valve engine producing 100 PS (DIN) at 12,000 rpm. Yet this is a power which is perfectly tamed to give you absolute confidence. Smooth delivery is, in part, thanks to an ingenious two stage Direct Air Induction System. At low speed, two outer ducts draw air into the 36 mm flat-slide CV carburettors to help optimize fuel flow and offer smooth, progressive acceleration. At over 20 km/h, the





system cuts off the outer ducts and opens the air flow from the second set of large diameter inner ducts which force the air towards the enormous main intake chamber - again maintaining the ideal fuel flow. The result is an impressive increase in low and mid-range power, with a full and steady torque curve throughout the rev range. With low fuel consumption and a 17-litre tank, the CBR600F also offers significant economy with the possibility of covering long distances without stopping for refuelling.

Ride like you've never ridden before

Fully faired, the CBR600F has an aerodynamic coefficient that helps make it one of the fastest bikes in its class. At high speed, the riding position is designed to create a natural balance between air pressure and torso





All in safety

The CBR600F is, of course, a superb sports bike. And, above all, it's a Honda, which means a great deal in terms of safety and reliability: the CBR600F features a double 296 mm fully floating front disc brake equipped with dual-piston calipers and a 220 mm disc at the rear. The race-style fairing ensures excellent protection, with the forward section producing additional aerodynamic forces to ensure that the front end remains stable at high speed. The design of the seat, together with the position of the handlebars and footrests, allows easy control of the motorcycle, particularly when accelerating and through curves. This safe and efficient performance also extends to other features such as the precision gear change, the quick-twist throttle and the adjustable front brake lever. Similar care and attention to ergonomic detail has been invested in the easy-to-use main petrol tap, head-light control, and the wide, vibration-free rearview mirrors, All add up to give you a comfortable riding experience that is unique to the CBR600F.

A refined, civilized sports bike

The CBR600F's high performance also extends to everyday use. Equipment includes a particularly quiet 4/2/1 exhaust system, a sidestand and a mainstand, luggage strap hooks, handlebar choke, a handy idle-adjustment screw and a bidirectional steering lock. The instrumentation uses the latest technology, including an electronic speedometer and tachometer which also keep wires and cables to a minimum. Another significant detail is built into the left sidepanel: a concealed, secure, yet easily accessible frame lug through which you can attach a U-type anti-theft lock (lock not included). The CBR600F is a motorcycle which, unusual among sports bikes, combines uncompromising performance with comfort. It's an irresistible combination – designed to give you the ultimate riding experience from an exceptionally fine machine.


